**TRIAL SUMMARY**

This proceeding involved a motor vehicle accident that occurred on July 17, 2019. The Plaintiff was struck by a vehicle attempting to make an unlawful U-Turn on a highway and sustained a complex leg fracture resulting in chronic pain.

The Plaintiff had an impressive work history building ziplines and suspension bridges. The Plaintiff alleged that he was unable to return to his job, which he loved, due to the devastating and disabling nature of his injuries and that he was disabled from most other forms of employment.

The Defendant denied that the Plaintiff's disability was as bad as claimed and alleged that the Plaintiff could return to some form of work.

The Plaintiff's case went to trial on January 6, 2025 and was heard by a Judge and Jury. Judgment was granted on January 24, 2025 and the Jury awarded the Plaintiff **\$4,457,829** in damages, essentially accepting every claim that was advanced on behalf of the Plaintiff.
